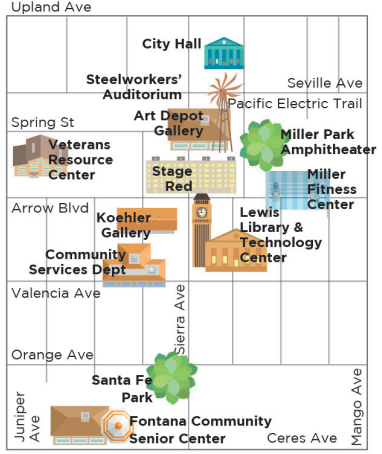

PAYMENT & FEES



- Accepted forms of payment: Visa, MasterCard, Discover, American Express, Check, Cash or Money Orders. For security purposes, identification will be asked to be provided for credit cards and checks.
- A \$3 administrative fee applies to all in-person transactions.
- A \$15 fee applies to all other non-residents (anyone living outside Fontana and not in the adjacent unincorporated county area).
- Some classes may require additional fees for class materials/supplies paid to the instructor. It is recommended the purchase of required supplies or class attire be done at the first class meeting.
- All checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$38 administrative fee, in addition to the class fee. The total fee will need to be paid in cash or money order at Fontana City Hall.

REFUND/CREDIT/TRANSFER POLICY

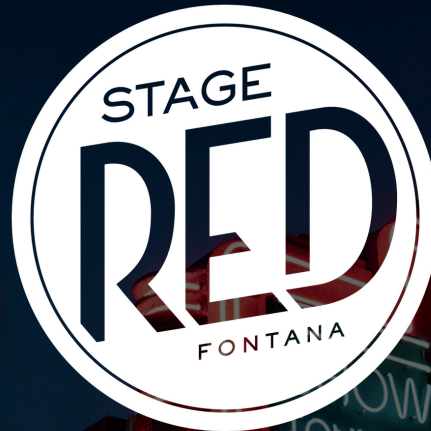

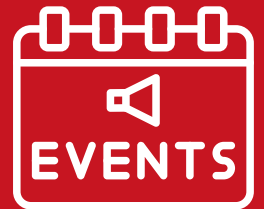
